Decatur-DeKalb Retired Educators Association Scholarship

The Decatur-DeKalb Retired Educators Association (DDREA), in partnership with Georgia State University/Perimeter College (GSU—Perimeter College Campus), in 2011, established a scholarship for students attending GSU—Perimeter College campus. Eligible students must pursue a major in education and be graduates of the Decatur City Schools or DeKalb County School District. The \$1,000 scholarship is awarded during the freshman or sophomore year to one eligible student enrolled at GSU—Perimeter College Campus. This scholarship amount almost covers the entire cost of tuition and fees for one semester.

Pat Warthan, DDREA Scholarship Chair, and Erica Harris, GSU—Perimeter College Director of Development, are currently collaborating on a plan to endow the scholarship at a minimum of \$40,000. This amount will firmly establish and maintain the scholarship to provide many years of continued support for future educators. The fundraising goal for 2019, is \$6,000. Each year, the goal amount will gradually increase until the endowment amount is attained. Any gift size will be greatly appreciated and will demonstrate your continued support in the development of future educators. **All gifts are tax-deductible!**
